Administration:

Currently working on software to improve purchasing and bill processing

- Reviewed mutual aid report to Mashpee. Past two months (due to Mashpee ambulances being out of service) number of mutual aid calls have increased. Commissioner Conley suggested meeting with the Town Manager again, show him the info we have, share options they had to solve their problem and to discuss what the future would look like if this situation doesn't correct itself. Commissioner Pisano hopes to have this clarified by the March meeting.
- Chief and Lt. McNamara met with USCG on the 11th regarding trying to coordinate a communication plan. Chief Harper offered to come into the station and help us with our program and that we are all communicating the same way and up on SOP's. Will also focus more on training and go to Crew training class and S&R with the CG. Commissioner Conley asked how many FF will be going, Chief responded will see how many interested in going, and need to discuss the budget (class cost is over \$4000 pp plus overtime). Commissioners supported three FF going to the class, will review again at March meeting.
- Reviewed current IOD status and budgets, and possible transfer of funds

Training:

- Have two interns from Mashpee High School
- FF had vehicle extrication last week-new FF got to use CFD equipment
- Two FF went to Maine for ice rescue training- had ice rescue with CFD (rescue equipment, dry suits)would like to have a rescue snare/stick for animal rescues
- Next month planning on using 56 High with smoke and victim rescue from second floor-Chief will
 provide the date.

Personnel:

 3 current IOD's. Two have given letters-physical needs to be completed by District doctor-good chance two of the FF will return by the end of the month. Third one being seen on the 28th and possible be cleared. One FF may be leaving for another department

Apparatus:

- Brush breaker-just received new tires. Waiting for quote about corrosion, plan on using end of year money if available, or wait until next year.

- State is buying the station new radios-switching to digital system
- Chief will prepare a budget for the next meeting with the two vehicles
- Will need to bring Commissioner Zais up to speed before the next meeting
