#### Administration:

- Interviews were conducted with FF/Paramedic candidates
- Lt. Assessment Ctr completed on May 10, 2023
- Final Grant disbursement request submitted for COMIR's and final check received (grant was started under Chief Rhude)
  - Commissioner Zais asked what the grant was originally written for?
    - Upgrade communication radios throughout fire house
  - Commissioner Pisano asked if all chargers were received? Money set aside for same?
    - Chief Brown responded that they were still waiting for the mobile chargers and monies have been set aside for them.

# TECHNOLOGY

- Trial run for Fire Rescue 1 Academy
  - Distributive education program

- Dovetail into the quarterly training objectives/consisten online learning platform that ties back into industry standards
- Assist Fire Dept. in obtaining an ISO rating in the future
  - Similar to EMS Program
- Phone system update
  - Chief recommends Secure Networks and MegaNet for phone service
    - Water dept uses MegaNet
      - \$7,708.62 for Category 6 powered cable throughout
        - Will allow all computers to be hard-wired
        - Upgrade phone system
  - Motion to move forward with proposal as described

- FF Gardner has completed the Fire Instructor One program at Brewster Fire Dept.
  O He is a Certified Fire Instructor
- FF Lee has started the Fire Officer One program at Onset Fire Dept.
  - Will certify him as Fire Officer
- Cotuit FD attended the town-wide ASHER (Active Shooter Hostile Event Response) program on 04.07.2023
  - Held at Barnstable HS
  - Town-wide program between all five (5) fire districts / Barnstable PD / Sheriff's office and a number of dispatching agencies
    - FF Emerson participated as an instructor
    - FF Lee, FF Staggs and FF McPherson participated as responders
    - Chief and Deputy Chief worked outside in the incident command post
- Lt. Amento attended Fire Prevention Officer Two
  - Being offered by MA Fire Academy at Hyannis FD
  - This will advance his skills in Fire Prevention and allow him add additional certification
- Chief and Deputy Chief met with a Wellness Coach to explain a grant funded health and wellness program that is being offered to the Cotuit FD and first responders on the Cape
  - Organization in Hyannis that rec'd some grant monies and they are offering mind/body/strength at no-cost to any first responder on the Cape & Islands
  - Deputy Chief and FF McPherson attended the FDIC Conference in Indianapolis (Fire Department Instructors Conference)
    - Largest dept instruction conference in North America
      - 35k attendees from 26 different countries
- FF McPherson attended two Hands-On live training that was put on by some of the countries best fire instructors
  - #1 Residential Search
    - Majority of fire related deaths are in residential handling

- #2 Hose Handling
  - FF McPherson learned new techniques
- Deputy Chief attended a number of leadership/management programs
  - Leading strategically and not emotionally when making decisions

## Training

- ASHER training
  - Purchased some add'l hostile response equipment

## Apparatus and equipment:

- UTV is now at Cotuit FD
  - Training will take place before put into service
- Breaker #267
  - $\circ$  Error in the calculations
    - Do we need a vote to void the last vote?
      - Commissioner Pisano stated that on the basis of new information, he suggested a motion be made to rescind prior vote.
        - Motion to rescind prior approval to accommodate new information.
          - All in favor.
      - Commissioner Conley suggested that it be moved to the base so that Cotuit FD will still have access to it
        - Motion to that Cotuit FD proceed to transfer housing of 267 to the base and expedite a warrant for a special district meeting to transfer title
          - All in favor.
