\$348,650.00 for the remaining expenses of the Fire Department, to be apportioned approximately as follows:

Maintenance, \$77,500.00,

Operating expenses, \$270,150.00, and

Miscellaneous, \$1,000.00

for a total appropriation of \$2,110,624.00.

\$5,087.00 for the labor and salaries for District Buildings Maintenance; and

\$18,882.00 for the remaining expenses of the Prudential Committee, to be apportioned approximately as follows:

Maintenance, \$11,357.00,

Operating expenses, \$7,425.00, and

Miscellaneous, \$100.00

for a total appropriation of \$23,969.00.

<u>Article 9:</u> To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer and appropriate \$7,000.00 to maintain the street lights of the District.

(The Prudential Committee recommends this Article)

<u>Article 10:</u> To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer and appropriate \$23,265.00 to support the Maintenance of the Cotuit Library.

(The Prudential Committee recommends this Article)

<u>Article 11:</u> To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer and appropriate \$539,716.00 for payment of principal and interest.

(The Prudential Committee recommends this Article)

<u>Article 12:</u> To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer and appropriate as/or borrow and appropriate the sum of \$971,000.00 for the purpose of paying employee/other post-employment benefits.

(The Prudential Committee recommends this Article)

<u>Article 13:</u> To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer and appropriate the sum of \$25,000.00 for the Stabilization Fund as provided under Section 5B, Chapter 40, of the General Laws.

Article 14: To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or transfer and appropriate the sum of \$45,800.00 for the Water Department Stabilization Fund as provided under Section IX, Section 5 of the District By-Laws

Article 15: To see if the District will vote to rescind \$15,000 of the \$100,000 debt authorized in Article 7 of the May 29, 2019 Annual District Meeting. The \$15,000 has been spent to make repairs to the Fire Station and will be funded by Free Cash because the District wishes to avoid the cost of borrowing for this small amount.
